

ORDINANCE NO. 10-4026

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Decatur, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That Section 2.5-9 of the *CODE OF DECATUR, ALABAMA* is hereby amended to read as follows:

“ (a) In addition to the hours of operation made unlawful by the provisions of Section 28-3A- 25 of the Code of Alabama 1975, it shall be unlawful for any person, whether a liquor, wine, or beer licensee or not, to sell, offer for sale or to serve or dispense for offer or reward, or to offer to serve or dispense for reward any liquor, wine, or beer for on premises consumption or off premises consumption, or to allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday of any week, or between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Sunday of any week; however, it shall be lawful for a duly licensed club retail liquor licensee to conduct such above described activities without limitation as to the hours of operation.

(b) The above provisions notwithstanding , it shall be further unlawful in the City of Decatur Corporate Limits within Limestone County, Alabama for any person, whether a liquor, wine, or beer licensee or not, to sell, offer for sale or to serve or dispense for offer or reward, or to offer to serve or dispense for reward any liquor, wine, or beer for on premises consumption or off premises consumption, or to allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises between the hours of 2:00 a.m. on Sunday of any week and 6:00 a.m. on the following Monday; however, it shall be lawful for a duly licensed club retail liquor licensee to conduct such above described activities without limitation as to the hours of operation.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and publication as provided by law.
